This early harvest Merlot Rosé starts with a very fragrant, aromatic bouquet leading into a well-rounded mid-palate finish on the tongue. Crisp dry notes with subtle hints of traditionally anticipated strawberries and hibiscus give way to a generous mouthfeel nuanced with hints of blackcurrant, rooibos and dried herbs, ending with a clean and clear natural acidity.

Wine Orbit Review – 91/100 Points, 4.5 stars*

This rosé presents in a crisp, dry style with hinting aromatics of strawberries and white florals. Melon, red berries and citrus trace the palate, as a natural acidity and generous mouth feel add balance. As the wine settles, it will mature with a subtle softening of the flavours, highlighting the wine's overall complexity.

An elegant and luscious barrel-fermented chardonnay. White peach and citrus on the nose, hints of stone fruit, marzipan and gunflint with almond meal on the palate, revealing biscuits and subtle butterscotch. A generous and creamy mid-palate is framed by a clean acid line which lifts the finish and adds persistence structure from the toasty oak and will develop over time in the bottle.  
Enjoy now with poultry or pork dishes, will cellar for 3-4 years.

Wine Orbit Review - 93/100 Points, 5 Stars*

The nose is reticent on first inspection, gradually opening to reveal an ethereal array of floral, forest floor and berry fruit. The palate has no such shyness, showcasing rich, bright flavours of Xmas cake, cherry, crème de cassis and spiced plum. The mouthfeel is velvety and opulent, before a rearguard of fine structural tannins reminds you this hedonistic youngster will also reward cellaring in the medium-term.

**Barrier Syrah 2018**

*Wine Orbit Review - 87/100 points, 4 stars*

This is an elegant Syrah displaying Bramble and Cherry Aromas with dried wildflower highlights. On the palate, Blackberries and raspberries are complemented by a dusting of cocoa, pepper and spice. The tannins are finely structured and elevated by fresh acidity, providing poise and liveliness

Note: This 2018 Barrier Syrah can be served chilled from the fridge to complement a summers day BBQ. Or at room temperature as an approachable fruit driven style of wine.

**Barrier Syrah 2014**

*Wine Orbit Review - 88/100 Points, 4 stars*

Dark, deep, black-hued red colour with slight garnet hues on the edge. The nose is firm with a well packed and dense core of blackberry fruit interwoven with dark herbs and earth, unfolding subtle notes of liquorice and spice, and some violet florals.

Medium-full bodied, the palate is fulsome and rich with a well-concentrated heart of blackberries, plums and dark raspberries intermixed with liquorice, spices and herbs.

<p>Cab Franc forms the base of the blend, giving intensity and depth. This is supported by the roundness of Merlot and the richness and structure of Carmenere. Cassis, plum and liquorice adorn the Nose with traces of dried oregano, leading to a more savoury palate of cedar and tobacco notes and an underlying rustic earthiness. Bold in structure, firm tannins provide the backbone for this blend, and natural acidity adds length to the dry finish.</p>		\$24	\$125

<p>The bouquet is classical Cru Bourgeois Medoc in a cooler year, with suggestions of cassis and plum over freshly polished leather, old roses and autumn leaves.</p> <p>The palate is still lively and fresh, if a little on the lighter side, with primary plum and berry flavours welcoming the forest floor umami magic of bottle age. Soft tannins, plump fruit and spicy French oak, this is a charming and impeccably balanced wine.</p>		\$24	\$125

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
